8. District Councillors Report

Cllr Sutcliffe commented on Moorber Croft regarding the state of the garden and stated he had been approached by members of the village to take action. Cllr Sutcliffe asked if the Parish Council on behalf of the electorate would raise the issue and proposed enforcement to look at the hedge height and the mix of windows, some of which are in white and some in charcoal colour. Craven Council Enforcement to be asked 1) the correct colour for windows in the conservation area 2) hedges - concern over road safety as the overgrown hedge restricts the view of traffic turning out of Moorber Lane onto A65.

9. Any other business

Locked gate- it had been reported to the Parish Council a gate on the footpath had been nailed shut by the tenant farmer, due to his concern over the gate not being shut properly and the sheep then able to get out onto the busy A65. The Chairman has spoken with the land agents for the owners, Davis & Bowring, who are looking at other options such as a spring gate to ensure it will close. The owners are to remove the nails and allow the gate to be used as the only other option is to cross a cattle grid.

Defib machine - Parish Council discussed again whether a defib machine should be installed at the village hall. Concerns over the requirement to have a team of responders, whether there is a need in the community and the ongoing costs for maintenance and repairs. It was decided the Parish Council would not make a decision but the Village Hall Committee asked if they felt a need for the machine.

Website - discussion as to what information should be put on the website, decision to only put the Parish Council required information, village events and any notices the Clerk receives from NYCC or CDC.

Mrs Bedford from Bell Busk raised concern over the lack of footpaths and signs in Bell Busk. Clerk to contact County Highways to request they speak to Mrs Bedford directly re the concerns.

Stainton Cotes - large amount of the hillside has been dug out and the removed soil left in piles. Cllr Sutcliffe to talk to Neville Watson of CDC.

Moorber lane sign and the footpath sign near Lowlands barn need to be replaced - clerk to contact NYCC.
