8. District Councillors Report

Cllr Sutcliffe commented on the formation of the new North Yorkshire Council and the fact the current buildings used by Craven District Council will become redundant and no decision has been made as to what to do with them. The new authority will come into place in May 2022 but there will be a transition year until May 2023 therefore anyone elected in the forth coming elections in May 2022, will stand for 5 years this time.

Contingency Plan - the residents of Bell Busk have requested the Parish Council draw up a contingency plan, after their recent experience of losing power following a storm. The contingency plan would include a list of contacts and to be placed in the notice boards and on the website. Clerk to review Gargrave PC website and draft first version.


Grants - the Chairman expressed a wish that any individual or organisation applying for a grant from a County Councillor should inform the Parish Council prior to applying, as the funds have to go through the parish council accounts. Mrs Helen Barrow applied for a grant but the Parish Council is still waiting for the funds to be deposited in the account, Clerk to chase up with NYCC. It was requested that an overview of the procedure relating to applying for grants be added to the website, clerk to draft wording.

Defibrillator- subject again raised by attendees at the meeting. Parish Council advised the costs is prohibitive and also requires monitoring on regular basis. The Coniston Hotel have a couple of defibrillators which it is understood are available for use by anyone. Clerk to confirm.

Flag Pole - residents of Bell Busk have advised of their intention to obtain funding towards a flag pole for the village. However, after discussion with Cllr Sutcliffe the issue relating to ownership of the land and/or potential planning application, the project is to be further reviewed.
